Dropout

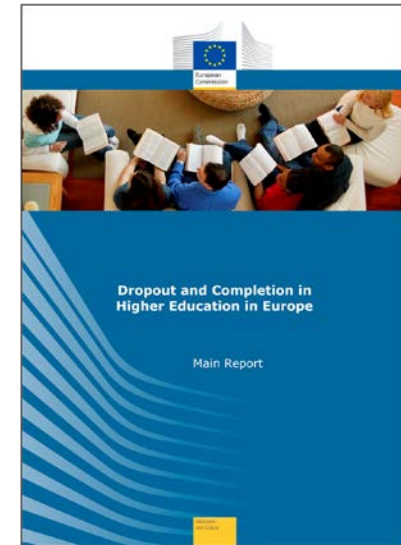
183,000,000 students in Europe

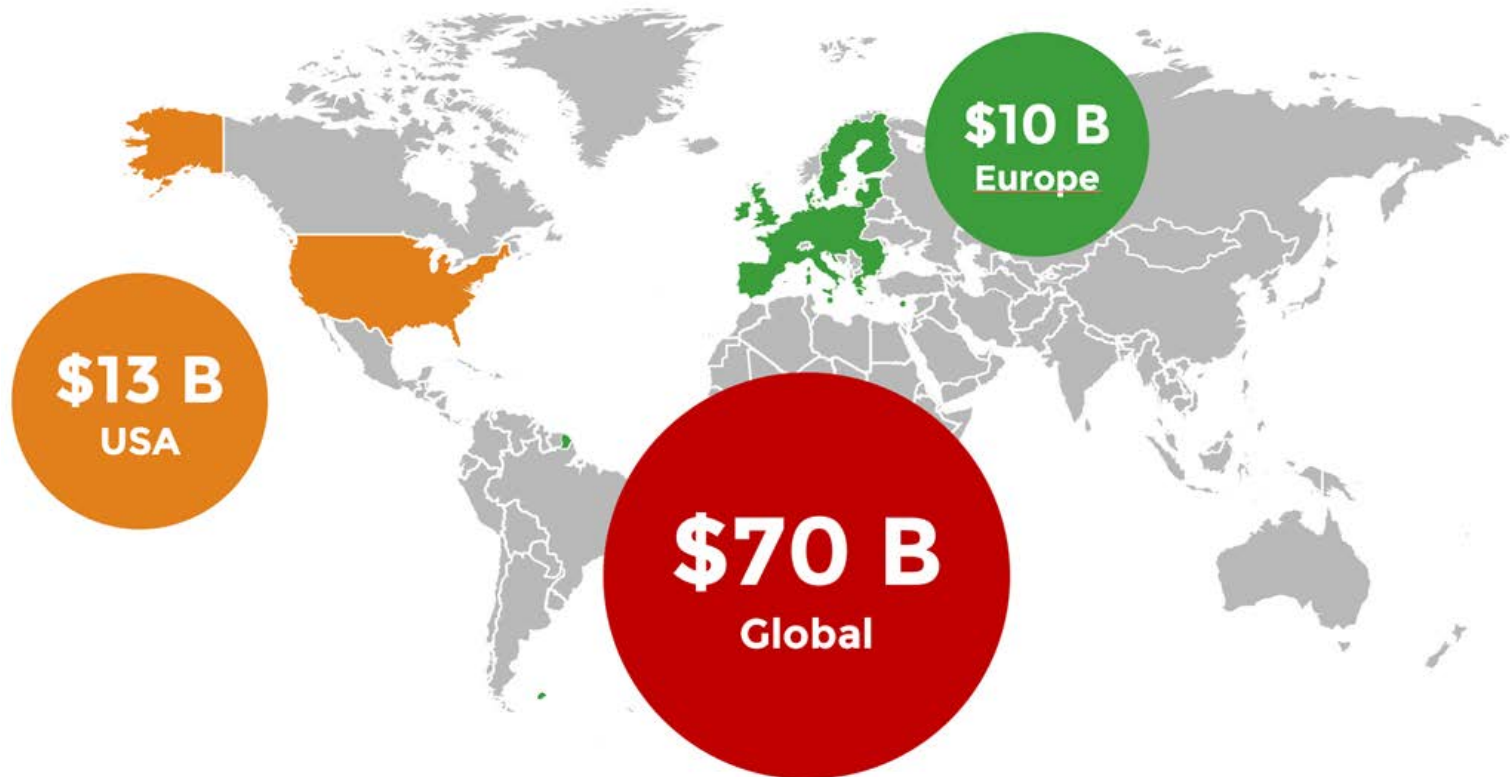

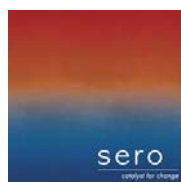
