Completing Your Application

Your application is split into four sections: Personal, Academic, Employment, and Review and Submit. We would like you to provide us with information in each of these sections.

Fields marked with a * are mandatory and must be filled in prior to submitting your application.

In addition, you will also be required to upload documents supporting your application.

To streamline the process, we have indicated other evidence that you will need to provide in each section:

Personal



Personal

- · A copy of your passport or birth certificate
- . If you are a non-British national living in the UK, a copy of your current UK residence permit
- · A personal statement



Employment

- . A copy of your Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume
- · Copies of certificates for any work based qualifications
- Evidence of any nonstandard qualifications, training or experience that may support your application



Academic History

- · Evidence of your academic qualifications such as certificates or transcripts
- · An English language certificate



Review and Submit

- · View and check your application
- When you are happy with your application, simply click 'Submit'
- · Post a message to your Admissions Advisor to let them know your application is ready for review

To view each section, click on the tabs at the top of the page. Moving to the next tab will automatically save any information. Alternatively, you can click 'Save' at the bottom of the page.
